
Operating Instructions Dumbbell-Barbell Adapters

Congratulations on your purchase of this fine Ironmaster product. Be sure to read and understand the operating instructions to achieve the best performance and avoid injury.






2x Barbell Adaptor 2x Knob

This device is designed to connect dumbbells to Olympic barbells, IM2000 or other equipment that a dumbbell weight can hang on the plate holder.

Use with dumbbells alone or use in conjunction with Olympic weight plates to increase your load.







Assembly: No assembly required, but you will need to be sure the chrome knobs are installed for use.

Operation: Remove the KNOB, open the hinge and center the clamp over the dumbbell handle. Make sure it is centered, close the hinge clamp and screw in the KNOB. Tighten the knob until the clamp closes completely. (Do not overtighten the knob it is not necessary).


Notes:


- Weight of each adapter is 5 lbs. For example, a 40 lb dumbbell as shown above will weigh 45 lbs total.
- Max dumbbell load rating is 185 lbs.
- Do not drop the barbell while using the adapters. They are not designed for dropping like bumper plates.
- The adapters are primarily designed for the Ironmaster Quick-Lock Dumbbells that have a 1.25" diameter handle. They may also work with many other dumbbells. Clamp width is 4.5". Use the provided spacer kit to fit down to 1.0" diameter handles. See page 3 for details on spacers.
- Do not use the adapters if the hinge clamp cannot close completely and the knob is not fully tightened.
- Handle on the adapter is to help load the weight onto a bar. It is not intended as an exercise grip.
- Not intended for exercises that can make the dumbbell swing.










You can apply one or both of the rubber strips on one side of the clamp if your dumbbells have a smaller handle diameter.

It is not necessary for the clamp to fit very tight on the handle, but it is recommended to fit snug enough so the adapter does not easily rotate/become unbalance once KNOB is tightened.



Use the adapter to add weight to your barbell setup in various ways as shown above.
